



















Latet is proud to announce that it was granted the Midot Certificate of Effectiveness. Midot is an NGO founded in 2008 by the JDC and Meitav, whose objective is to assess the effectiveness and impact of NGOs (i.e. their ability to create social value and improve the quality of life of their beneficiaries). The seal was awarded to Latet, accompanied by a letter attesting that Latet is "committed to an organizational culture that gives great importance to planning and measurement, focuses on results and on continued improvement, in order to influence its beneficiaries and bring about a significant change for the better in their lives." In addition, it is noted that "the management processes led by the organization to promote the effective advancement of its social goals are prominent and worthy of special mention". Latet was awarded the certificate for three years, instead of two as it usually is.

LATET IN PASSOVER

The food drive was held in **187 branches** of the Shufersal supermarket chain during morning and evening shifts in order to collect food for families in need. **13,835 food boxes** were collected over 8 days, with participation from **6,275 volunteers** and **278 coordinators**.

VOLUNTEERS EVENT

As we do each year, we held an evening dedicated entirely to Latet's volunteers on the 4th of June. 1,000 volunteers attended the event and enjoyed a volunteering performance by the great "Hatikva 6" band at the famous "Barby" club, with an atmosphere of Israeli celebration. At the event, certificates of excellence were awarded to volunteers who were exceptionally outstanding during their year of volunteering. A special award was also granted to six volunteers who have been taking part in the organization's activities for over a decade.

MID-WAY SEMINAR

On March 6, 2018 the mid-year seminar for the activities of Latet Youth took place. The "Mid-Way" seminar indicates the end of the "Exposure stage" during which the participants are exposed to populations in need in Israeli society and get to know the world of humanitarian aid. This seminar then introduces the beginning of the "Entrepreneurship stage" – a stage in which each Latet Youth group plans and executes a social project for a community in need within its own city. The participants in the seminar enjoy enriching content that stimulates motivation and enhances their teamwork and collaboration abilities. In addition, the seminar connects them to the values and work of the Latet organization and Latet Youth. This year about 1,200 members attended the seminar and, thanks to the Latet Youth program, they now volunteer, become involved in their communities, lead, and initiate for a better and just society.





END-OF-YEAR EVENT

On June 14, 2018 we held an event which marked the end of the year of activity and highlighted the best social initiatives of the year at Latet Youth. Out of 160 groups, 15 groups were selected to present their activities to the management teams of Latet and Mizrahi Tefahot Bank – Latet Youth's partner for the last 6 years. Among the initiatives are: "Make a Wish" for Holocaust survivors, construction of a therapeutic garden for special needs children, an event for cancer patients and their families, accessibility for the disabled awareness campaign, and more.



We provided **44 local NGOs** with equipment: blankets and radiators, industrial fridges and freezers, kitchenware for soup kitchens

"LATET MORNINGS"

During the first half of the year, we hosted two NGO collaboration meetings at our logistics center in Har Tuv. Some 40 partner NGOs' directors took part in the panels and held fascinating and empowering talks on issues which are essential for a successful joint operation. The positive responses from the participants and the ability to use the learned tools in the field strengthen the communication and the connection between Latet and the NGOs and within the NGOs themselves.





CENTRALIZED PURCHASING

The Latet organization has significant purchasing power due to the large volume of food purchases it makes on a regular basis. In order to enable the local partner NGOs to benefit from this purchasing power and even to influence it, we have launched a permanent and accessible platform through which the NGOs can purchase food according to their needs, at the same prices as Latet.

FOOD RESCUE PROJECT WITH THE SHUFERSAL CHAIN

This initiative brings together around 70 Shufersal branches and 50 of our local partner NGOs. The NGOs rescue food directly from the branches and distribute it to families and individuals who are suffering from nutritional insecurity. In order to raise awareness of the Shufersal chain's customers and staff for the project, together with the chain we created branded baskets which can be seen in the fruit and vegetable sections of the chain's branches with the inscription: "We rescue fruits and vegetables for families in need".



REUSABLE BASKETS DISTRIBUTED TO THE PARTNER NGOs AHEAD OF PASSOVER

As an umbrella organization for 180 local NGOs, assisting them in their ongoing work, this year we chose to equip the NGOs with reusable baskets that make it easier to pack food. The reusable baskets are comfortable and of high quality, with convenient handles for carrying by hand or on the shoulder and are capable of carrying more weight. They are lightweight, foldable, and do not take up space. They are even friendly and good for our environment.

THE SOCIAL LAB

In July 2016 Latet set up a social lab for the first time in Israel (in cooperation with the ERI research institute) which is an incubator for the development of innovative solutions in the field of poverty and food insecurity. The goal of the lab is to develop the most effective intervention model to solve the nutritional insecurity problem and to design an innovative and groundbreaking solution that can be implemented on a large scale nationwide.

The lab was set up after a pilot for a nutritional security program was conducted in Bat Yam and showed that although a varied food package worth \$135 was provided to the families, there was no improvement in their nutritional security situation.



Studies of interventions in the realm of food in developed countries found that only about 30% or less of the participants were alleviated from nutritional insecurity. In contrast, the lab results show that:

- 52% of the families were alleviated from hunger at the end of the third stage.
- 73% of the participants were alleviated from hunger in at least one of the intervention stages.



When we add the three components of the current study, we can achieve the highest percentages of hunger alleviation. All three stages had a significant effect on improving the families' nutritional security situation.

We are currently working on follow-up studies regarding the social lab:

In the next stage, our objective is to build a joint model for a sustainable alleviation from food insecurity and poverty through cooperation with an intervention program which deals with poverty relief, aimed at increasing income through employment.

PURIM

As in the past years, we collected and distributed "Mishloach Manot" (the Purim food baskets) to Holocaust survivors in need. About 2,000 baskets were delivered to the survivors together with greetings written by children from all over the country, in order for the survivors to enjoy a happy Purim. In addition, a Purim party was held in cooperation with Intel Corporation in Petah Tikva.







7 social events for Holocaust survivors have been held by the program since the beginning of the year.

100 apartments of Holocaust survivors in need were renovated since the beginning of the year as part of the Restoration Project.

"We started volunteering in the program almost ten years ago, and about eight years ago we started visiting F. She knew us as a couple of single students, then as a married couple and about three and a half years ago as parents. PASSOVER

Ahead of Passover, seven social events for Holocaust survivors in need were held across the country and attended by about 650 Holocaust survivors with the support of more than 300 volunteers. These events took place thanks to cooperation from several companies and their huge desire to delight Holocaust survivors for the Holidays: Medinol, Intel, Bank Leumi, AppsFlyer, Isracard, Cloudinary and the Dan Caesarea Hotel.

All of the Holocaust survivors in the Aid for Life program received food boxes adapted for the Holiday, and boxes were also distributed to additional Holocaust survivors who asked for specific assistance on the eve of the Holiday.





RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT ISRAEL



More than **17 companies** took part in our food boxes packing activities in Passover

A COLLABORATIVE PACKING SITE

On Good Deeds Day, Latet set up the first collaborative packaging site of its kind in Israel, in cooperation with Kiryat Atidim (high-tech district of Tel-Aviv). During the day, companies from the area including Ness Technologies, Abbott, and NSO group could walk out of their building to participate and enjoy a volunteering and giving event. Together, the various companies packed around 2,500 food boxes for Holocaust survivors and families in need for Passover.





DONATE AND PACK

As we do every Holiday, this Passover Latet teamed up with a number of leading companies, including IAI and Applied Materials, whose employees donate and pack food boxes for Holocaust survivors and families in need. As part of this activity, some 5,500 food packages were packed and distributed directly to Latet's partner NGOs and from there, to the Holiday tables of disadvantaged families.





INTERNATIONAL RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT



This is the second year we partnered with the Jewlish Facebook page and created digital content to collect donations for holiday meals. Together, the videos gathered: 2M views, 27K shares, 18K likes, 4K comments

INAUGURATION OF A LATET TRUCK

This past May we had the pleasure of inaugurating a new truck donated by the Fondation Lucette Guedj under the umbrella of the Fondation du Judaïsme Français. The generous donation was made in memory of Lucette Guedj, a French teacher, who was always sensitive to social issues. Her sister was impressed by our work, felt there was a natural connection between her late sister's will and our action, and therefore decided to help thousands of families by facilitating the food distribution with a new vehicle.



LATET IS GOING INTERNATIONAL

In our efforts to introduce Latet's action to international audiences, we are always thrilled to host delegations from foreign countries. Among these visits, we would like to highlight the group from the Jewish Federation of Greater Philadelphia, our long-time partner, who arrived to participate in a fascinating talk about food rescue, and the Guatemalan Congress representatives who came to our offices to learn more about our vast experience. We also have had the privilege to present Latet to two important French Jewish institutions: we were invited to speak at the FSJU Gala in Lyon, France, and we received the visit of the Executive Office of the CRIF who came to our headquarters. It is always an honor to share our know-how, and even more so to lead and inspire the fight against poverty abroad.

SEEING LATET - COOPERATION WITH THE OPTICA HALPERIN CHAIN

In honor of the Purim Holiday, we initiated a first of its kind collaboration with Optica Halperin (leading Israeli eyewear chain): in the chain's stores and next to the regular glasses stand, we displayed another stand with colorful plastic glasses for Purim costumes. The plastic glasses were sold at \$2.5, and for each purchased pair, the Optica Halperin chain matched the donation with an additional \$2.5. That way, people bought a pair of glasses and donated twice as much.



PASSOVER CAMPAIGN

On Passover, we led a campaign to collect holiday meals with the message "Give a meal as a gift". For tens of thousands of families, the best holiday present is a meal. Parents of celebrities such as Gal Gadot, Statik, Rotem Cohen, Tal and Ido Museri mobilized for the campaign. The parents asked their children to donate a meal to people who really need it instead of buying them an unnecessary gift.
