We are honored to share with you Latet's 2019 Social Impact Report.

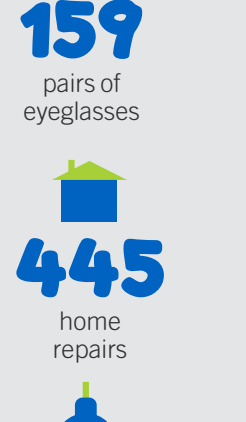
In the report we present to you data about the main achievements of our intervention programs and the organization's activities this past year.

Our deepest thanks to all our dear donors, partners and volunteers, who trust us and allow us to successfully meet pressing social challenges and to sustain meaningful and effective social action.

Besides the monthly distribution of food boxes to 1,000 impoverished Holocaust survivors and social support - both executed by personal volunteers - we have also organized 22 social events for them throughout the year and renovated 445 apartments with the purpose of offering a safer and more accessible living environment.

In addition, our Emergency Fund has provided 159 pairs of glasses, 100 dental treatments, monthly adult diapers to 75 survivors, 34 SOS panic buttons and 28 survivors received necessary home equipment they were lacking.

Thanks to our collaboration with one of the leading companies in Israel and the support of the general public, we are currently distributing hundreds of winter packages for elderly people and Holocaust survivors in need. As of December 2019, 200 of these packages were distributed to Holocaust survivors who are part of our aid program.

Two delegations of ENT specialists arrived from France for a very special project dedicated to distribute hearing aids to Holocaust survivors living in poverty. Together with Latet staff, the specialists performed tests and adjusted hearing aids to 169 survivors across the country.

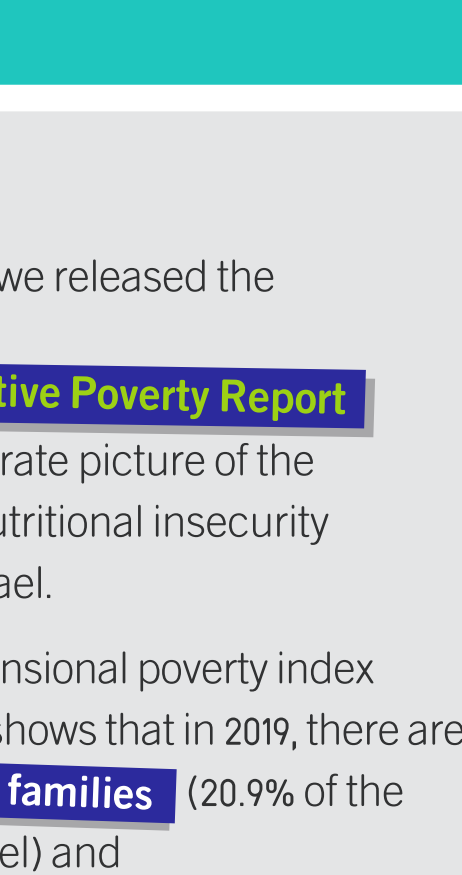

This year, Latet Youth members brought together 60,000 other teens to participate in this day, dedicated to say thank you to nurses, security guards, cleaning people and so many more who are too often taken for granted. In addition, awareness activities were held in schools all over the country.

The multidimensional poverty index used by Latet shows that in 2019, there are

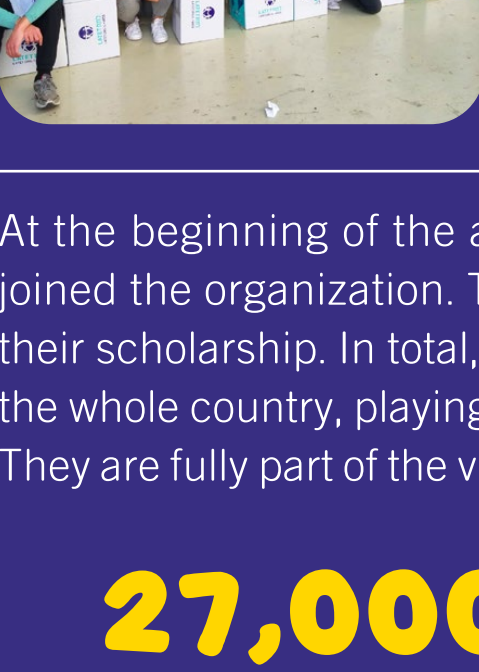
530,000 poor families (20.9% of the families in Israel) and

2,306,000 individuals (25.6% of the population) live in poverty, among which

1,007,000 children (33.5%).

VOLUNTEERS

Volunteers and partners along the way



Following an annual tradition, we organized an event to give recognition to our volunteers and partners. More than 1,200 people attended this amazing evening. They enjoyed a great performance by "Hadag Nahash", one of the most famous Israeli bands, and were treated with refreshments that were donated for the occasion. A special award was given on stage to the most outstanding volunteers of 2019.



As part of the Rosh Hashanah national food drive, in partnership with the leading supermarket chain Shufersal, we collected more than 15,000 food boxes with the help of 3,000 volunteers, which is 16% more participants than last year. We estimate that about 200,000 people donated food products in this particularly successful

At the beginning of the academic year, 350 scholarship recipients joined the organization. They will volunteer within the framework of their scholarship. In total, about 900 scholarship recipients operate in the whole country, playing a significant part in our different programs. They are fully part of the volunteer force of the organization.
