## PROVIDING VITAL WINTER SUPPLIES FOR DISPLACED FAMILIES

With over 200,000 residents still evacuated from the Northern and Southern parts of Israel, and as temperatures drop, it is becoming absolutely necessary and urgent to provide families with the most basic winter items - both to evacuated residents as well as Holocaust Survivors, the elderly and soldiers operating in difficult conditions.



Latet is distributing comprehensive winter kits to families in dire need, helping them to feel at home even if their home is far away. Each kit costs \$72 and contains a variety of items including socks, gloves, scarves, warm blankets, hot water bottles, and umbrellas. We will provide these essential kits to 16,000 families nationwide. So far, 7,500 kits were already distributed.
